Aseptic Techniques For Pharmacists

A program designed to meet the requirements of the Texas State Board of Pharmacy (TSBP) for pharmacists who prepare compounded sterile products (CSPs).
12 Home Study Hours + 8 Contact Hours = 20 Hours Total

Who Should Attend: This program is intended for pharmacists who want to meet the Texas State Board of Pharmacy requirements for pharmacists who compound sterile products or supervise technicians in these activities. Topics will also include basic principles of parenteral nutrition and fluid and electrolyte balance, venous access devices, and intravenous admixture compatibilities.

OBJECTIVES

Upon completion, the pharmacist should be able to:

1. Explain TSBP rules related to CSPs.
2. Describe USP Chapter ,797> standards for CSPs
3. Perform calculations required in preparing and administering intravenous drugs.
4. Describe requirements and technique for preparation of CSPs in a laminar flow hood.
5. Determine compatibilities and stabilities of CSPs.
6. Describe various venous access devices.
7. Demonstrate mixing and handling of parenteral drugs.
8. Safely prepare and handle chemotherapeutic agents.
9. Describe principles for assessing patient nutritional needs, developing a nutritional formula, and monitoring for effectiveness and avoidance of adverse effects.
