

Program Description:

Aseptic Techniques For Pharmacy Technicians

A structured program designed to meet the requirements of the Texas State Board of Pharmacy for pharmacy technicians who compound sterile products.
20 Home Study Hours + 20 Live Contact Hours = 40 Hours Total.

Who Should Attend: This program is intended for pharmacy technicians who desire to increase their knowledge of aseptic techniques and the compounding and dispensing of intravenous medication, cytotoxic, and hazardous drugs. To pass the exams in this course, the pharmacy technician or pharmacy technician trainee will have to pass written exams, including mathematics used in pharmacy calculations, and demonstrate proper technique in preparing compounded sterile products.

OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this course, the pharmacy technician or pharmacy technician trainee should be able to:

1. Discuss parenteral drug therapy delivery systems.
2. Discuss principles of sterility.
3. Discuss Texas Pharmacy Rules related to compounding sterile products.
4. Perform pharmaceutical calculations used in compounding sterile products.
5. Determine compatibilities and stabilities of compounded sterile products.
6. Demonstrate the proper cleaning and use of a laminar flow hood.
7. Demonstrate the proper handling and compounding of sterile products.
8. Safely prepare, store, and handle chemotherapeutic agents.

Students will complete approximately 20 hours of home study, including reading and homework assignments. In addition there will be 20 hours of live instruction at the following times:
